

Ulrich Volz is a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Economics at SOAS, University of London. He is also a Senior Research Fellow at the German Development Institute (DIE) and an Honorary Professor of East Asian Economics at the University of Leipzig. Ulrich previously taught at Peking University, Hertie School of Governance, Freie Universität Berlin and Central University of Finance and Economics. He has spent stints working at the European Central Bank and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development and held visiting positions at the University of Oxford, University of Birmingham, ECB, Bank Indonesia, and Aoyama Gakuin University in Tokyo. He was also a Fox International Fellow and Max Kade Scholar at Yale University. Ulrich has been an adviser to a number of central banks, international organisations and development agencies. His areas of expertise include money, banking and finance; open economy macroeconomics; international economic interdependencies; and global economic governance. Ulrich has published widely in these areas. He is the co-editor-in-chief of the Asia Europe Journal.
